¹HBT Member Scholarship (\$400)

This scholarship is available to members of Harvest Baptist Temple who are supporting the various ministries (other than the school). The member must be an active member who attends (at least one-time a week and who tithes*) To receive this scholarship, you must fill out the form and have it verified by the treasurer who will check the giving records on file. This completed, signed form must then be turned into the school principal. This scholarship is available for multiple children in the same family. Please submit this form by July 31.

Janice Rhineberger Scholarship Fund

This scholarship is available to only a select few who show a definite financial need and are HBT members. Applicants must have a face-to-face interview with the principal. Varying amounts are available depending on the qualifying need. This scholarship is offered when funds are available.

Harvest Temple Scholarship Granting Organization (HTSGO)

This scholarship provides financial assistance toward tuition costs for families with definite financial need. Potential applicants must submit an application along with a face-to-face interview with the principal.

NOSF (Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund)
